Jaipur's monuments and museums now available for wedding shoots, for a fee

A NEW policy of Rajasthan government now allows the public to get exclusive access to historical monuments, such as forts, and museums in Jaipur for pre-and post-wedding shoots by paying a fixed sum. Senior officials of the state Art, Literature, Culture and Archaeology Department said a notification in this regard was issued on February 1 and an order was issued the next day. "The issue of such shoots was earlier embedded in the ticketing system and was not institutionalised. We have observed that people who want to be a part of pre- and post-wedding shoots want to shoot exclusive pictures without the crowd because it's a special moment for them. It also adds to experiential tourism for the public as it becomes a moment of their life which they will never forget and they may also come back to

mark anniversaries of the event," Mugdha Sinha, secretary of the department, told The Indian Express. She said the policy, for now, will be implemented in Jaipur, which has the most demand for such shoots in Rajasthan. "As per the new rules, if somebody wants to shoot pre-and post-wedding shoots at such historical monuments/museums, then they will have to pay Rs 5,000 for every two hours if the shoot is during office hours. For shoots before or after office hours, they will have to pay Rs 15,000 per hour," said Prakash Chandra Sharma, director of Archaeology and Museum Department, Jaipur. As per the order, the applicant will have to deposit an additional sum equivalent to 25 per cent of the booking amount as a refundable security deposit. Sharma said that while such shoots have happened earlier as well, there was no proper guideline in this regard. The locations where the

shoots can be done after taking permission and paying the sum include Amber palace, Albert Hall, Jantar Mantar, Hawa Mahal, Nahargarh, Vidhyadhar ka Bagh, Sisodia Rani ka Bagh and Isarlat. "People who don't mind getting the shoot done with the crowd around can do that within the official hours and for that we are charging a nominal amount. For others who want more privacy and maybe VIP individuals, they will be allowed a little exclusive privilege and we have given them a leeway of doing it one hour before or after the opening or closing of the monument. The charges will be comparatively higher for that," said secretary Sinha. The conditions for approval mentioned in the department notification include that the parties will follow all the guidelines and make sure that no antiquities are damaged and that they will not engage in acts or shoot films that "may hurt the sentiments of the public or their religious sentiments".

No cabinet expansion in state as of now, says Maken

AICC GENERAL secretary in-charge for Rajasthan, Ajay Maken on Wednesday ruled out the expansion of the state cabinet as of not but said nearly 30,000 district-level political appointments will be made in the first half of the current month. He said the cabinet expansion will not take place as of now in view of the upcoming Budget session of the state from February 10.

Maken said the Congress office-bearers have been asked to visit districts assigned to them and they will meet local leaders to discuss names for district-level appointments to various committees of government departments. On an average, 150 workers get appointed to such panels in an Assembly constituency. There are 200 Assembly constituencies in state's 33 districts. "The office-bearers will be

submitting the names by February 8 or 9. Our efforts are that appointments at the district-level, which are around 25,000-30,000, are made in the first fortnight of February," he told reporters in Jaipur on Wednesday. Maken also held discussions over results of polls to urban local bodies and upcoming bypolls to four Assembly seats with

Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and senior party leaders. The bypolls have been necessitated due to the deaths of Congress MLAs Bhanwar Lal Meghwal (Sujangarh), Kailash Trivedi (Sarada), Gajendra Singh Shaktawat (Vallabnagar) and BJP MLA Kiran Maheshwari (Rajsamand). The election schedule is yet to be announced.

Corruption charges: IPS officer remanded in police custody

AN IPS officer arrested on Tuesday by the Rajasthan Anti-Corruption Bureau on corruption charges was remanded in police custody for two days on Wednesday, according to an official.

IPS officer Manish Agarwal was produced before a court in Jaipur, which remanded him in police custody for two days, ACB DG B.L. Soni said. Agarwal's name had cropped up in a case in which a petrol pump owner, Neeraj Meena, was arrested for allegedly demanding Rs 38 lakh money from a construction firm on the officer's behalf.

A 2010-batch IPS officer, Agarwal is currently posted as the commandant of the State Disaster Response Force, Jaipur. He held the charge of the Dausa SP at the time of the alleged incident.

Soni said some documents recovered during a search of his house are being examined.

The company owner had complained to the ACB, alleging that district administration and police officials had been demanding bribe for facilitating a highway construction project in Dausa. After the verification of the complaint, the ACB on January 13 arrested two SDMs and petrol pump owner Neeraj Meena. Neeraj Meena was arrested for demanding a bribe of Rs 38 lakh on behalf of Agarwal, who a week earlier was transferred from Dausa to Jaipur. Manish Agrawal held the post of the SP Dausa from July 6, 2020 to January 6, 2021.

Indo-US joint military exercise 'Yudh Abhyas' to begin on February 8

THE 16TH edition of Indo-US joint military exercise 'Yudh Abhyas' will be held in Rajasthan between February 8 and 21, a defence spokesperson said on Wednesday.

The exercise near the India-Pakistan border aims at enhancing cooperation and interoperability between the two armies and will focus on counter-terrorism operations under the United Nations mandate, the spokesperson said.

"The drill comes days after the air forces of India and France held a five-day joint exercise in Rajasthan in January.

Defence Spokesperson Lt Col Amitabh Sharma said, "As part of military-to-military exchange programmes, US Army troops will be arriving in India on February 5 for the 16th edition of Exercise 'Yudh Abhyas' with Indian Army troops."

He said the bilateral training exercise will be conducted at the Foreign Training Node at Mahajan Field Firing Ranges.

He said the 11th Battalion of Jammu

and Kashmir Rifles, part of the South Western Command will represent Indian Army in the exercise while the US Army delegation will be represented by the troops of 2nd battalion, 3rd Infantry Regiment of 1-2 Stryker Brigade Combat Team along with respective brigade headquarters. "Exercise with US Army is significant in terms of security challenges faced by both the nations in the backdrop of global terrorism. The joint military exercise will enhance the level of defence cooperation between both armies which will also foster the bilateral relations between both nations and reiterate India's key role as a key partner in the Indo-Pacific region," he said in a release.

The exercise being held in India also assumes significance in the backdrop of recent developments on northern borders, and conveys the strategic posture of the two nations as well as enhanced upward trajectory in Indo-US relations, he said.

"The exercise is being conducted despite the Covid-19 pandemic which indicates the strength of bilateral relations and conveys a geo-strategic message to the environment," the release said.

Govt to open 500 AYUSH wellness centres

Jaipur: The Rajasthan government will open 500 AYUSH health and wellness centres in the state, Health Minister Raghu Sharma said on Wednesday.

In order to increase the popularity of Ayurveda, Homeopathic and Unani systems of medicine and to connect with medico tourism, the AYUSH centres would be opened soon, he said.

Sharma said the state government is committed to strengthening and expanding Ayurveda, Homeopathy and Unani systems of medicine.

He said that the benefits of these medical practices and the facilities being provided by the state government will also be disseminated so that the people can take advantage of them. PTI
