Slogans against Muslims: No bail for 3; court says 'undemocratic'

ADELHI court has refused to grant bail to three men arrested for raising inflammatory and anti-Muslim slogans at Jantar Mantar on Sunday, observing that their "scathing remarks" were "undemocratic and uncalled for from a citizen of this country".

Link Metropolitan Magistrate Udbhav Kumar Jain rejected the bail pleas of Preet Singh, Deepak Singh Hindu, and Vinod Sharma on Thursday.

On August 11, the court had granted bail to Supreme Court lawyer and former BJP spokesperson Ashwini Upadhyay, the organiser of Sunday's protest against "colonial-era laws" at Jantar Mantar.

The court had said that "investigation in the present matter is at nascent stage; however, that does not imply that liberty of a citizen be curtailed on mere assertions and apprehension".

In the case of the three men, the court observed that "even the FIR is silent with regard to commission of offence" under Section 153A of the IPC, which relates to promoting enmity between different groups on grounds of religion, etc.

However, in its orders on the pleas moved by Deepak and Preet, the HC said that it had and played some portions in open court.

"In one of the (video) clippings, applicant/accused, as identified by the IO (investigating officer) in the video clipping, can be seen making scathing remarks which are undemocratic and uncalled for from a citizen of this country, where principles like secularism hold the value of basic feature imbedded in the Constitution," the court said.

It underlined that while the "freedom to express oneself is indeed allowed to be enjoyed by the citizens to the fullest possible extent," "with every right there is a corresponding duty attached".

"The principle behind Section 153A IPC is to preserve religious/communal harmony and it is the duty of every citizen that while he enjoys his right to express himself, he preserves religious harmony," the court said. "This indeed is the positive aspect of secularism," it said.

Lawyers for Preet, Rudra Vikram Singh and Ashwani Dubey, told the court that their client was not present at the time of the incident, and had not been named in the FIR.

Advocate Avadh Kaushik, who appeared for Deepak, claimed that his client had been falsely implicated in the case.

The prosecution had argued that the presence of the accused had been confirmed by video footage of the protest. The court clarified that "at this stage, it cannot check the veracity of these video clippings, which is a matter of appreciation of evidence to be done at a later stage".

"Besides, there is no time stamp available at this stage on these video clippings for which proper investigation has to be done. This court cannot interfere with the ongoing investigation," it said.

TAMIL NADU BUDGET Petrol to be cheaper by Rs 3

DAYS AFTER releasing a white paper that flagged Tamil Nadu's alarming overall debt of Rs 5.70 lakh crore, state Finance Minister Palanivel Thiaga Rajan Friday unveiled a budget with several generous announcements including one to reduce the effective rate of tax on petrol by Rs 3 per litre to provide relief to "working-class people".

The decision would result in a loss of revenue of Rs 1,160 crore a year, Thiaga Rajan said.

The revised budget for 2021-22, he said, fulfilled the major election promises of the DMK. One of these was the monthly cash assistance of Rs 1,000 for women.

Thiaga Rajan said the state government will soon identify families eligible for this. The potential beneficiaries are not required to change the name of the head of the household in ration cards to avail the benefit.

The minister hiked the food subsidy to more than Rs 8,000 crore, announced a Chief Minister's Insurance Scheme at a

The Tamil Nadu budget had several measures focused on Tamil language and culture. Here are some of them:

- Strengthening the use of Tamil as the official language 'from secretariat to field'
Declaration of Keezhadi, Sivakalai and Kodumanal as protected archaeological sites.
Allocation of ₹5 crore for archaeological excavations
Announcement of first stage of deep-sea excavations in Sangam-era harbours of Korkai and Azhankulam

cost of ₹1,046 crore, and granted Rs 703 crore as subsidy for free bus travel for women.

There were also a number of "green announcements".

The budget document promises a 'Green Fund' based on a green seigniorage cess to ensure that abandoned quarry sites are secured and restored, the 'Singara Chennai 2.0' plan for a clean and green Chennai, and a 'Green Tamil Nadu Mission' to increase the green cover in the state to 33% of its geographical area. The Finance Minister also set aside Rs 100 crore to help restore around 100 wetlands.

For rural areas, the budget document announced a guarantee of 25 crore man-days of MNREGA work and allocated Rs 3,800 crore for rural housing this year. The budget also aims to construct houses for eight lakh homeless families in the next five years, said Rajan. He also allocated Rs 48.48 crore for upgrading Anganwadi centres.

An underground sewage scheme has been announced for 27 towns with a population of more than Rs 1 lakh. Ten new arts and science colleges will be opened and Rs 5,369.09 crore has been allocated for higher education.

Two bodies recovered in Meerut, police probe underway

New Delhi: Two unidentified female bodies were found in Meerut on Friday. According to police, a team of police and Crime Branch officials reached the spot after locals informed them that two bodies had been spotted inside a drain. The bodies were fished out and sent for post-mortem. While the police

have not out murder, they are waiting for the preliminary report to file a case.

"Since it appears that the bodies were in the drain for quite some time, they had considerably swollen up. Our present focus is to identify the bodies since that will make the case clear. The photos of the bodies are being

verified from local villages and queries will be sent to neighboring districts as well. If there is a matching missing persons complaint, it will give us the needed information," said Keshav Kumar, SP (Rural)/Meerut.

As per police, the bodies were clothed and the deceased are likely to be in their late 20s.

Police have not recovered any ID or mobile phones on the bodies. Locals claimed that there are chances that the two hailed from a different region other than Meerut. They further stated that the appearance suggested that they could be from Northeast India which was denied by the police.
