Man lynched in UP's Kushinagar after he 'shot teacher dead'

A 25-YEAR-OLD man was beaten to death by a mob after he allegedly shot dead a government school teacher at Rampur Bangra village in Kushinagar district of Uttar Pradesh on Monday morning.

According to police, 25-year-old Aryaman Yadav was seen running around the terrace of a house and shooting in the air when he was overpowered by a group of villagers who thrashed him with sticks and stones.

In the videos of the lynching that have gone viral, policemen can be seen present as villagers beat Aryaman to death.

Later in the day, the local station house officer, Harendra Kumar Mishra, was suspended for negligence.

Police said that Aryaman reached 35-year-old Sudhir Singh's ancestral home at Rampur Bangra village around 8 in the morning on a two-wheeler. "During the preliminary inquiry, it has come to light that around 8.00 am, Aryaman visited Sudhir Singh's house on a Scooty. Aryaman told Sudhir's family that he has come from Gorakhpur and is a friend of Sudhir's elder brother Rajesh Singh, who works as shiksha mitra in Kushinagar. The family allowed him to come inside and asked him to sit in the drawing-room as Sudhir was taking a shower. When Sudhir entered the drawing-room, Aryaman immediately pulled out a pistol and shot Sudhir in his chest. Sudhir died on the spot," Circle Officer (Tamkuhira) Phool Chand Ram said.

Uttar Dinajpur 'custodial death' case: Five cops face inquiry

Kolkata: Days after a BJP worker died during police questioning in Uttar Dinajpur district's Raiganj station, an investigation was ordered into the alleged role of five policemen on Monday.

The five officials were allegedly present at the station when 24-year-old Anup Roy was questioned on September 2 in connection with a case of robbery.

According to sources, the inquiry was initiated after Roy's family registered a complaint. In its letter, the family accused the officials of beating Roy to death.

Last week, the police had dismissed the allegations of custodial torture and death, and claimed that the BJP worker fell unconscious after suffering a "brain haemorrhage" while being interrogated about the robbery, which occurred on August 28. He was taken to a hospital, but was declared dead on arrival.

Spread word about NEP among stakeholders, PM tells Governors

THE NEW National Education Policy (NEP) doesn't belong to one government but the country and it should be implemented in letter and spirit, irrespective of who is in power, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Monday.

Calling for a wide-ranging discussion in the country on policy implementation, the Prime Minister said the awareness among students, teachers and parents about the NEP should be as comprehensive as the stakeholder consultation that led to the drafting of the policy itself. The key to NEP's success, he said, lies in stakeholder involvement. "It is equally important that our awareness (about the NEP

and its provisions) should be as deep and wide-ranging as the consultation process. It's important to discuss all the provisions and nitty-gritty of this document. It can only be implemented once all doubts and questions in people's minds are addressed," he said at the inaugural session of the annual Governor's Conference hosted by Rashtrapati Bhawan.

"When we move towards change, it's natural for doubts and questions to arise in people's minds. Parents may wonder how the move to dissolve subject streams would affect their child's future. Teachers may want to know how the curriculum for such studies will be designed. Stakeholders could have questions about availability of adequate resources to meet the objectives of the NEP," he said, requesting all Governors present at the conference to hold virtual events till September 25 in their respective states to improve the understanding of the policy among the stakeholders.

The Prime Minister credited the wide-ranging consultation undertaken by the Education Ministry in the drafting stages for the NEP's acceptance in the country.

He further highlighted provisions of the NEP on exposure to vocations. He said practical training or vocational training at a young age would help make India atmanirbhar (self-reliant). "To make India atmanirbhar, it's important for our youth to be skilled. Vocational exposure at a young age and practical learning will help them become employable and this will also increase our share in the global job market," he said.

"The new National Education Policy also talks about tackling brain drain. If the world's best universities come to India then students will not want to study abroad. Also, our universities will become more competitive with the entry of foreign universities," he added.

ABILITY TO TRAVEL AT 6 TIMES THE SPEED OF SOUND

DRDO successfully flight-tests hypersonic technology vehicle

THE DEFENCE Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) on Monday successfully flight-tested a Hypersonic Technology Demonstrator Vehicle (HSTDV), which is an unmanned scramjet vehicle with the ability to travel at six times the speed of sound.

The test was conducted at 11.03 am from Dr A P J Abdul Kalam Launch Complex at Wheeler Island, off the coast of Odisha. The HSTDV tests the indigenously developed hypersonic air-breathing scramjet technology. The scramjets are a variant of air-breathing jet engines and have the ability to handle airflow of speed much higher than the speed of sound. Hypersonic speeds are five times

– or more – than the speed of sound.

In a series of tweets, the DRDO stated, "In a historic mission today, India successfully flight tested the Hypersonic Technology Demonstrator Vehicle (HSTDV), (which is) a giant leap in indigenous defence technologies and a significant milestone towards a Sashakt Bharat and Atmanirbhar Bharat. DRDO, with this mission, has

demonstrated capabilities for highly complex technology that will serve as the building blocks for NextGen Hypersonic vehicles..."

In a statement, the Ministry of Defence said, "The hypersonic cruise vehicle was launched using a proven solid rocket motor, which took it to an altitude of 30 km, where the aerodynamic heat shields were separated. The cruise vehicle separated from the launch vehicle and the air intake opened as planned. The hypersonic combustion sustained and the cruise vehicle continued on its desired flight path at a velocity of six times the speed of sound, which is nearly 2 km per second, for more than 20 seconds. The critical events... demonstrated technological maturity. The scramjet engine performed in a textbook manner."

PALGHAR LYNCHING

1 staffer dismissed, 2 retired, pay cut for 15: Police to SC

MAHARASHTRA POLICE has told the Supreme Court that it dismissed one of its personnel, compulsorily retired two others and reduced the pay to minimum for 15 others in connection with the Palghar lynching of two sadhus and their driver on April 16.

In an affidavit filed in the top court, which is hearing petitions seeking independent probe into the crime, the state police said it had filed two chargesheets

against 126 accused persons.

A departmental inquiry was also ordered against the personnel "who have been prima-facie found negligent and derelict in the performance of their duties..." Accordingly, one Assistant Police Inspector has been dismissed, one Assistant Police Sub Inspector and one police driver compulsorily retired from government service, and pay reduced to minimum for varying periods for one Sub Inspector, one Head Constable and 13 Police Constables, the affidavit added.

Man crushed to death under elevator in Mumbai

Mumbai: Aman was crushed to death under an elevator in Worli on Sunday. The deceased, Vishal Mewani (46), had gone to the building, to visit a doctor. Police said, "The deceased pressed the button to go to the second floor. Upon stepping inside, Mewani realised that he was standing below the elevator car..."

The elevator was instead on the second floor. Mewani was trapped as the door shut and did not open."
